**April 28 - 29 Saturday/Sunday – BSA Camp Brosig near Sealy, Texas**

Our program is designed especially for Venture age youth training with their adult leaders. Fees are \$135.00/person including overnight accommodations/camping and all meals beginning with Saturday lunch. We have an optional program Friday evening for our youth participants. Camping is available Friday night for those with long travel distances. Financial assistance, full or partial scholarships are available for youth participants. All youth participants must be fourteen or older "by the last scheduled class meeting" or registered Venturers/Sea Scouts. **Current Adult CPR/AED Training from a approved nationally recognized training agency is a prerequisite.** Complete details will be provided with your registration packet.
